

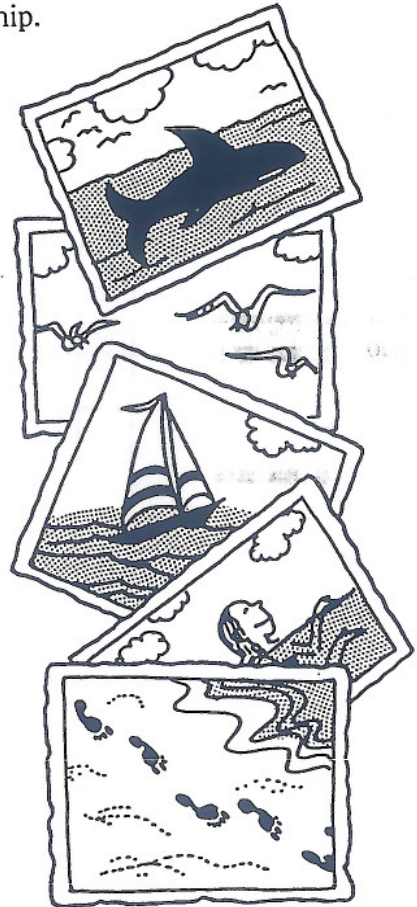
SEASHORE SNAPSHOTS

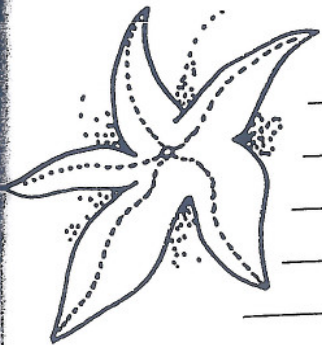

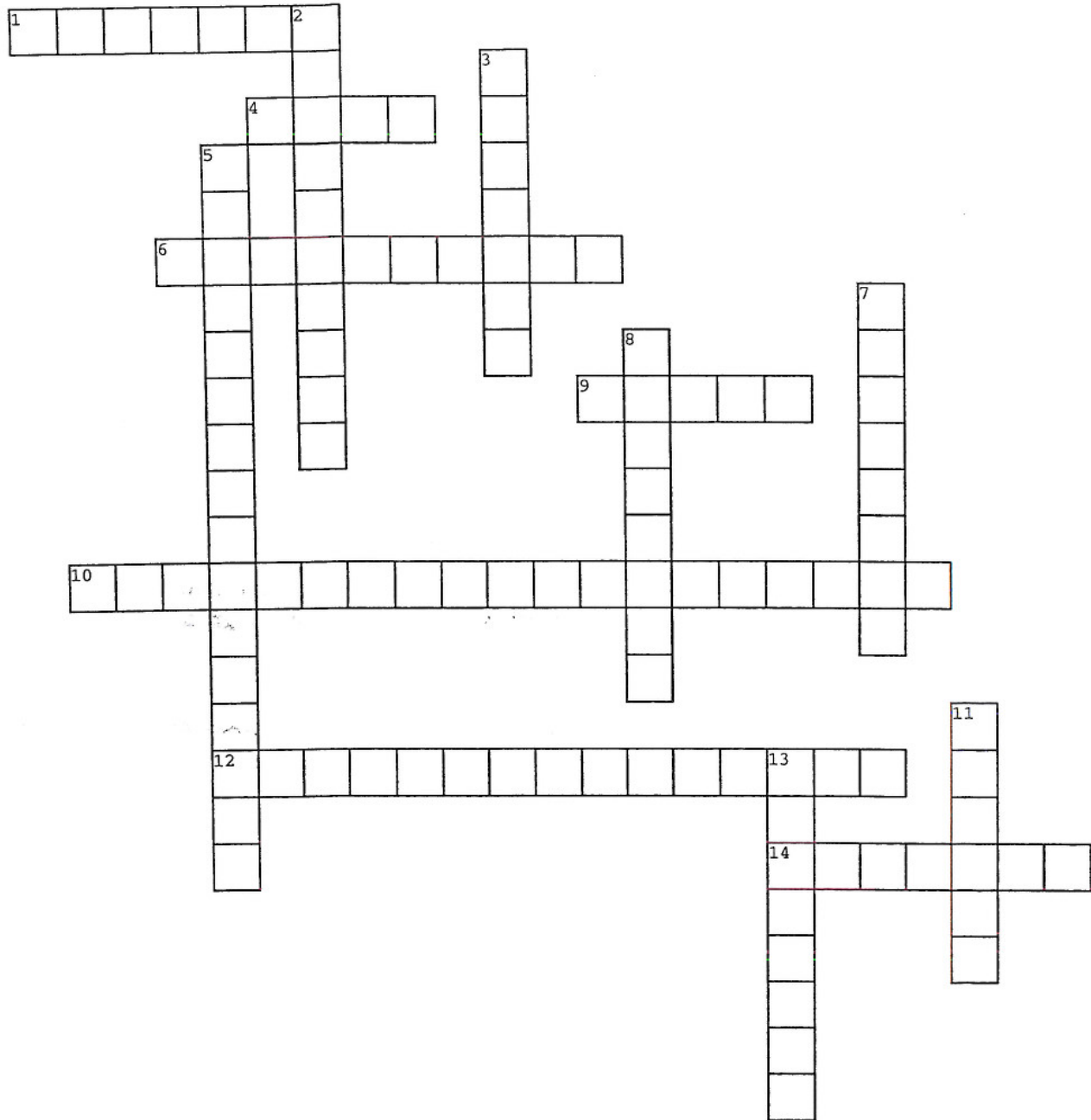
